COMPETITION & GAMES INFORMATION

Games kick off at 10.00am with last games being played at 2.30pm.

Following the final games there will be a presentation for all grade winners.

This will be held in the Pioneer Rugby Football Clubrooms.

Games will start & finish on the referee. Please ensure you are on the field ready to go at start time.

Footwear must be rugby boots. Mouth guards must be worn.

Games will be **16-minutes long, with 8-minute halves.**

Half time will consist of changeover of ends – maximum 1 minute allowance for half time.

Subs will only be permitted at half time.

Each referee will keep score, and this will be taken as confirmed score.

Whanau & friends are very welcome to come along on the day and support all our rangatahi!

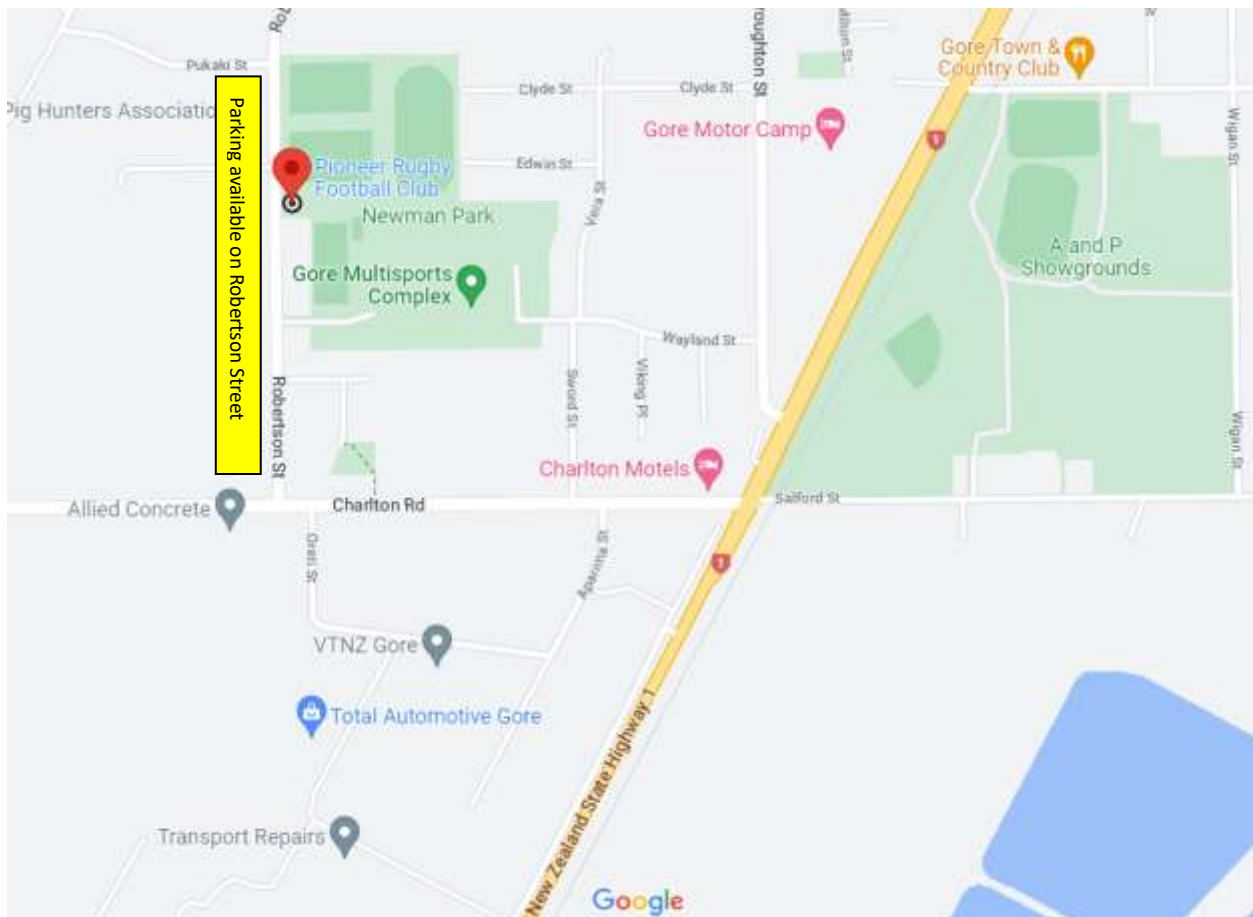
